We are eager to return and share the ministry of music again with them hopefully this spring. But now with Covid cases rising, and the weather turning colder, the board has decided that we must suspend our rehearsals until the beginning of January 2021.

Essential workers and front-line workers are applauded for their work in keeping the economy going and keeping us safe and healthy.
